## *Division of Bridges* *Rehabilitation of the Brooklyn Bridge*

November 2010


CB 1 and 3 (Manhattan) and CB 2 (Brooklyn)

The New York City Department of Transportation is currently performing rehabilitation work on the Brooklyn Bridge ramps and approaches. This work began in the spring of 2010 and continues until 2014. Signage and traffic agents will guide traffic detours.

Exit 2 from the southbound FDR Drive splits into two ramps - to the left is the access to the Brooklyn Bridge, and to the right is the Manhattan Civic Center. Access to the Manhattan Civic Center, only, will be closed for two consecutive nights. From midnight on Monday November 29 to 5:00am on Tuesday November 30 and the following night, Tuesday November 30 at midnight to 5:00 am Wednesday December 1, traffic from the FDR southbound headed to the Manhattan Civic Center will:

- Exit the southbound FDR Drive at South Street (Exit 3).
- Continue on southbound South Street to RF Wagner Plaza.
- Make a right turn onto westbound RF Wagner Plaza.

**This detour is only for traffic headed to the Civic Center in Manhattan from the FDR Drive. Traffic bound for the Brooklyn Bridge will take Exit 2 as usual.**



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Night time deck replacement work will resume on the Centre Street and Park Row ramps to the eastbound/outbound Brooklyn Bridge in Manhattan. Beginning November 29th, 2010, these ramps will be closed Mondays through Saturdays from 1:00 am to 6:00 am for approximately three weeks.
