- A presentation on gang awareness and resistance for young children will be conducted by Police Officer Keith O'Donnell from NYPD.
- Attendees will also participate in interactive skill stations on fire safety escape planning, pedestrian safety, nutrition and obesity awareness, CPR and first aid, consumer products safety information, healthy homes/bedbug prevention, domestic violence resources, and stress management for practitioners. They will learn techniques for sharing injury prevention tips with their patients and clients.

BY BUS

- M15 to 27th Street and 1st Avenue
- M16 crosstown to 34th Street and 1st Avenue, walk 7 blocks south
- M26 crosstown to 23rd Street and 1st Avenue, walk 4 blocks north



BY SUBWAY

- No. 6 local (Lexington IRT line) to 28th Street stop
- Walk 1 block south and 4 blocks east.



BY CAR TO BELLEVUE'S SOUTH LOT ENTRANCE

COMING FROM 34TH STREET (EASTBOUND)


- Take 34th Street as far east as possible, and make a right on the service road adjacent to the entrance to the southbound entrance to the FDR drive. Follow service road (past NYU) and you will see a tall, grayish/brown building (Bellevue) in front of you.
- Bellevue is now on your right and the FDR is to your left. Go past the building and turn right, into the Kinney Parking Lot.

COMING SOUTHBOUND DOWN FDR

- Take FDR to 34th Street exit. Follow service road (parallel to FDR) for about 6 blocks, continuing across 34th Street continuing on the service road (past NYU) and you will see a tall, grayish/brown building (Bellevue) in front of you.
- Bellevue is now on your right and the FDR is to your left. Go past the building and turn right, into the Kinney Parking Lot.

OTHER PARKING POSSIBILITIES

- Metered parking spots are available along First Avenue and street parking can be found on the side streets. Please be sure to check posted signs for street cleaning and alternate-side parking rules.
- There are also several parking garages located near Bellevue Hospital. The following is a partial list. Please check with each individual service provider for rates and hours.
 - West Plaza Garage - 460 Second Avenue at 26th Street
 - 350 E. 30th Parking - 30th Street between First and Second Avenues
 - Imperial Parking - 25th Street at Second Avenue
 - Central Parking System - 530 First Avenue at 30th Street (under NYU Medical Center)
