Late Monday night February 28th, the New York City Department of Transportation (NYCDOT) will close **one lane** on the northbound FDR Drive between E.70th Street and E.104th Street. Late Tuesday night, March 1st, NYCDOT will close **two lanes** between E.96th and E.104th Streets. Crews will install temporary warning signs and prepare the staging area for electrical operations associated with the bridge rehabilitation. Work will be completed by 5 a.m. on Wednesday, March 2nd. This project is weather sensitive; a revised work schedule and notification may be required. The closure schedule follows:

Lane Closures --Northbound FDR

One lane - 11 p.m. through 5 a. m., Monday, February 28

Two lanes - 1 a.m. through 5 a.m., Tuesday, March 1

One lane of traffic will remain open at all times



Alternate Routes

Expect delays during this period. The alternate northbound route is 1st Avenue between the 96th Street exit and the entrance ramp at 127th Street.
