## **Fall - Winter 2011 Bridge Closure**

The New York City Department of Transportation is continuing the rehabilitation of the Wards Island Pedestrian Bridge. In order to perform the remainder of contract work, the bridge must be closed to the public. On November 1<sup>st</sup> 2011, the bridge will be moved to the raised position to complete the project. The anticipated completion date for all work is the early summer of 2012. A project update will be provided early next year.



Pedestrian access to all facilities on Randall's Island remains available via the Manhattan span of the RFK-Triboro Bridge at 125<sup>th</sup> Street and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue as well as via the Bronx at Cypress Avenue and Bruckner Blvd.
