Beginning September 19th and continuing through October 21st 2011, the New York City Department of Transportation will close the westbound lane on the Shore Road Circle Bridge to permit the erection of structural steel on the Shore Road Circle Bridge (Orchard Beach Road) over the Amtrak Railroad. The work hours are between 10:00 p. m and 5:00 a.m. the next morning. Additionally, intermittent 15 minutes closures during each hour will take place in both the eastbound and westbound directions, between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. All traffic in the queue must dissipate before a second 15 minutes closure can occur.

Westbound Single Lane Closure: 10:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m.
Westbound & Eastbound Two-Lane Closure 1:00 a.m. - 5:00 a.m.

One traffic lane will remain open at all times.
Pedestrian access across the bridge will be maintained during this work
