

- Add parking lane stripe




Proposed Loading Changes

- Update Parking Regulations to “No Standing Anytime”
 - 47 Feet from Street Racks to crosswalk
- Facilitate loading and unloading
- Reduce double parking
- Improve traffic flow
- Improve safety for right-turning vehicles
