

Northbound Bruckner Expressway Closure Friday 6/22/12 – Sunday 6/24/2012


The New York City Department of Transportation is currently performing rehabilitation work on the Northbound & Southbound Bruckner Expressway Bridges over Amtrak/CSX Railroad. To facilitate this work, a closure of the northbound Bruckner Expressway (main line) is necessary. In addition the Bruckner Expressway ramp from the RFK / Triboro Bridge, the 138th Street ramp to the northbound Bruckner Expressway and the on-ramp from Bruckner Boulevard (service road) onto the Sheridan Expressway will be closed. These closures will occur from 11:59 p.m. Friday, June 22, 2012 to 10:00 a.m., Sunday, June 24, 2012. Traffic agents will be stationed at key intersections to assist traffic movement.

CLOSED: Bruckner Expressway ramp at the Sheridan Expressway Motorists driving northbound on the Bruckner Expressway will be prohibited from proceeding further and are asked to use the following detour to rejoin the Expressway northbound. 1: Stay right for Exit 49 (Sheridan Expressway / East 177th Street)


2: Follow the Sheridan to the next exit – Westchester Avenue.

3: Make a right onto Westchester Avenue.

4: Make the 1st right off Westchester Avenue onto Bronx River Avenue.

5: Follow Bronx River Avenue apx .4 miles to Bruckner Boulevard (service road)

6: Make a left onto the Bruckner Boulevard (service road) and proceed apx. .7 miles to rejoin the expressway.
