




# Example of Bike Lane Design




#### **Proposed Bike Lanes Locations**

#### Install bicycle lanes on:

- South side of 29<sup>th</sup> street
  - (between Madison and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenues)
- South side of East 30<sup>th</sup> street
  - (between 8<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Aves, 6<sup>th</sup> and Madison Aves, Park and Lexington Aves)


# Example of Shared Lane Design



#### **Proposed Shared Lanes Locations**

#### Install shared lanes on :

- East 29<sup>th</sup> Street
  - (between Lexington and Madison Aves)
- East 30<sup>th</sup> street
  - (between 7<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Aves, Madison and Park Aves)

Curbside turn lane Frees up through travel lanes Increases visibility of crossing pedestrians


Dedicated Bicycle Lane Organizes Street Dedicates space for cyclists


West 29<sup>th</sup> Street (btw. 12<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> Aves)

# Locations of Turn Lanes - UPDATED

- Install 5 turn lanes
- Repurposes approximately 23 parking / loading spaces

Mostly daytime metered commercial parking





- Reductions from original proposal
  - Turn bay locations: 9
  - Parking spaces repurposed: 53
