Merrick Boulevard Bridges Over Northbound and Southbound Laurelton Parkway

Due to the forecast of inclement weather for the weekend of October 30, weekend repair work on the Merrick Boulevard Bridges is rescheduled to begin November 6.

The anticipated completion date for the weekend work is now December 14, 2009

In June, 2009, the New York City Department of Transportation Division of Bridges continued the rehabilitation of the Merrick Boulevard Bridges over northbound and southbound Laurelton Parkway. The project is now in the final phase of completion. Full-depth concrete repairs and paving of the bridge approaches will be performed on weekends.

During the weekends one half of Merrick Boulevard, between 237th Street and Brookville Boulevard, will be closed to traffic. One 12-foot traffic lane in each direction will remain open at all times. Traffic will not be detoured during this operation.

***Weekends Friday evening, 9 p.m. to Monday morning 5 a.m.
Weekday Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.***

The scope of remaining weekday work includes sidewalk repairs, paving at the approaches, and deck concrete spall repairs. This remaining weekday work is anticipated to be completed by December, 2009.
