

## NYCDOT – Downtown Brooklyn Surface Transit Circulation Study Project Area Description



The study includes both a primary study area that is limited to the downtown core and a secondary study area that includes the lower density neighborhoods that immediately surround Downtown Brooklyn.

### Primary Study Area Boundaries (Clockwise from 12 o'clock)

Red Cross Place/Adams Street/Tillary Street/Navy Street/Ashland Place/Lafayette Avenue/St. Felix Street/Hanson Place/S. Elliot Place/Academy Park Place/ S. Portland Avenue/6<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Dean Street/Flatbus Avenue/Pacific Street/4<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Atlantic Avenue/Court Street/Joralemon Street/Clinton Street/Cadman Plaza West

- Includes MetroTech, Civic Center, Fulton Mall and Atlantic Ave commercial corridors, Colleges/Universities, BAM cultural district, Atlantic Terminal/Atlantic Yards
- Criteria for defining primary study area
  - Major CBD land uses, including commercial/office/court/cultural/higher education
  - Immediately adjacent high density residential and park uses
  - Takes into account areas under redevelopment

### Secondary Study Area Boundaries

Union Street to the South, Vanderbilt Avenue to the East, Waterfront to the North and West

- Includes DUMBO, Vinegar Hill, Fort Greene, Fulton Ferry, Brooklyn Bridge Park (under development), Brooklyn Heights, Cobble Hill, Boerum Hill, Park Slope (part), Prospect Heights (part)
