

NYC DOT will improve conditions along Broadway and in Union Square by:

- Making East 17th Street between Union Square West and Union Square East one-way westbound to improve safety.
- Simplifying traffic signal timing on East 17th Street and Broadway for improved pedestrian safety.
- Working with the Union Square Partnership to create new plaza spaces in the reclaimed roadbed along Broadway and East 17th Street for enhanced public space.
- Installing a protected bike lane along Broadway from 23rd to 17th Streets for increased safety and mobility.
- Adding pedestrian islands along Broadway for easier and safer crossings.
