Note: Section 2 – 05 of Highway Rules for the issuance of Construction Activity Permits:

Section 2 – 05 (d) (2) through (5)

(2) The street shall be protected with proper covering to prevent damage; e.g.: planking, skids, plating, pneumatic tires, before construction material or equipment, including containers are placed on the street. All planking and skids for containers must be a minimum of 1 ½” to a maximum of 3” thick. Overall size must be a minimum of 12”x12” and the placement of the protective covering must not exceed the outer dimensions of the container. Protection shall be placed directly under each steel wheel or roller of the container to adequately distribute the weight. Placement of all protection shall be done upon delivery by the managing agent, distributor, or owner of the container.

(3) The name, address and telephone number of the owner shall be printed on two sides of each container used for construction debris.

(4) Each container shall be stored in an area designated by the Commissioner for the storage of construction material.

(5) All containers shall be clearly marked on all four sides with high intensity fluorescent paint, reflectors, or other markings capable of producing a warning glow when struck by the head lamps of a vehicle or other source of illumination at a distance of three hundred feet.
