Records relating to the offices of the:

**Ferries**

Records relating to the operation of the Staten Island Ferry and private ferries.

**Budget & Capital Program Management**

Records relating to capital budget plans, financial reports and records, performance and accountability.

**Grants & Fiscal Management**

Records relating to grants, compliance, contract payments, accounts payable, revenue and accounts receivable.

**Human Resources and Facilities Management**

Records relating to recruitment, staffing, employee relations, organizational and

employee development, compensation and benefits, payroll, HR information management, labor relations services, permit management, facilities and security management.

### **Permit Management and Construction Control**

Records relating to the customer support for applicants and permittees, the review of applications, land contour development plans, and construction activity stipulations and regulations for the City's streets and highways.

### **Roadway Repair and Maintenance**

Records relating to DOT's Fleet, maintenance and repair of the City's streets and highways.

### **Sidewalks and Inspection Management**

Records relating to the banner program, emergency response, highway inspection and quality assurance, newsracks, sidewalk management, pedestrian ramps, and special events.

### **Traffic Operations**

Records relating to signals and street lighting, parking and City owned garages, parking meters, speed camera program and other system engineering and automation enforcement.

### **Transportation Planning & Management**

Records relating to the operation and planning for street infrastructure that regulates traffic flow, parking, and commercial deliveries for the safety of motor vehicle occupants, pedestrians and bicyclists.
