

**CB 1 and 3 (Manhattan)**

The New York City Department of Transportation is performing rehabilitation work on the Brooklyn Bridge ramps and approaches. The entire span will also be repainted to prevent steel corrosion. This work will commence in the spring of 2010 and continue until 2014. On April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010, Frankfort Street between Gold Street and Pearl Street will be temporarily modified to allow one lane of traffic in each direction. To accomplish this:

- A concrete barrier will be placed along the center line of Frankfort Street, to create a staging area and work zone, while maintaining one lane of traffic in each direction.
- The concrete barrier will begin 150 feet west of Pearl Street and end at Gold Street, in order to accommodate the local M22 bus stop that is now located just west of Pearl Street.
- All standing and parking along this segment of Frankfort Street will be prohibited.
