## **Project Description**

After retooling the existing Chinatown Information Kiosk (Kiosk) and hosting community visioning sessions, the project partners will activate several key entrances into the district through short-term physical and programmatic interventions. These will then inform the re-envisioning of the Canal Street Triangle (CST) and its transformation into an iconic neighborhood landmark and community resource.

### **Project Objectives**

- Reopen the Kiosk at CST as the information center for the community engagement process
- Study and enhance the district's significant entrances and spaces through public realm activations
- Facilitate connections between Chinatown and the surrounding neighborhoods, fostering spaces of exchange and setting the stage for future efforts
- Explore CST's current and potential function, form and significance through public visioning sessions and engagement
- Transform CST into an iconic neighborhood landmark and community resource
