

Love seat.

Until your child is at least eight years old or over 4-feet 9-inches tall, use a real love seat– a booster seat or a child safety seat. A booster seat is needed once your child has outgrown his or her safety seat.

A booster seat raises a child up so the seat belt fits, preventing the child from being thrown from the car in a crash.


