Provide curb space during daytime and evening hours to allow for activities such as:

- Package deliveries by commercial vehicles
- Taxi and car service pick-up and drop-off
- Active loading and unloading of personal vehicles

This program seeks to:

- Use No Parking regulation to reallocate curb space from 7 AM to 7 PM Monday to Friday
- Reduce the number of double parking incident as well as other unwanted standing behaviors, creating a safer and more efficient environment for all road users
