## What is Allowed on the Staten Island Ferry? Guide for E-bikes & Mobility Devices\*

## **Effective November 1, 2021**

- Charging of any **E-bike or other mobility device** (lithium) battery is prohibited onboard the Ferry
- Bicycles and Class 1-3 e-bikes are permitted onboard the Ferry
- Mobility devices identified below as requiring an operator's license, operator's license endorsement, vehicle registration or license plates are not permitted on the Ferry
