- Add concrete islands at the following locations:
 - West Thames between West St and Battery PI
 - West Thames between Battery PI and S End Ave
 - S End Ave at W Thames St
 - S End Ave at Rector St (north side)
 - S End Ave at Albany St
 - S End Ave at Gateway Center Entrance
 - S End Ave at Liberty St
- New left turn bay on S End Ave at Albany St
- New neckdown on Liberty St at S End Ave
- New yield crosswalks on S End Ave at W Thames St and Rector St
