"The Great Struggle for Cheap Meat" is a musical in the streets based on the 1902 Kosher Meat Boycott led by Lower East Side housewives.

Composed by Michael Hickey, libretto and direction by Ryan Gilliam, performed by the teen company members of Downtown Art.



The performance, which lasts a little more than an hour, will wind across Lafayette Street to the east and west, from East 4th Street to Bleecker Street. Audience members hear the music and dialogue on individual mp3 players synced to the action.



Admission is free, but advanced registration is required due to limited capacity. Wear comfortable shoes and arrive 10 minutes early for training on your mp3 player.

The start location is the northeast corner of East 4th Street and Lafayette Street, at 11:00 am.
