Background

Summer Streets 2015 presents, "Postcard Project," a participatory art event produced in partnership with Chashama, within Rudin Plaza on the NE corner of 51st Street and Park Avenue at the Uptown Rest Stop. On the first three Saturdays in August, the interactive art workshop provides Summer Streets participants with the opportunity to color, personalize, write and decorate a postcard addressed to a person of their choosing, to Mayor de Blasio, Summer Streets or even to New York City. Connie Perry, artist and writer, will be leading participants through the process by providing markers, pens, pencils, crayons and 5 1/2" x 3 3/4" postcards with a "DeaR" salutation at the top. After postcards are completed, each person will be given the option to take their work home or display it on a clothesline installed around the tent for all to see and appreciate.
