SITE SPECIFIC PROPOSED ACTIONS

4.1 INTRODUCTION

As previously discussed, the City's SWMP proposes the development of four Converted MTSs in order to allow for the containerization and barge or barge-to-rail export of DSNY-managed Waste. The four proposed facilities would be located at the sites of existing MTSs, specifically North Shore in northern Queens, East 91st Street in Manhattan and Hamilton Avenue and Southwest Brooklyn in Brooklyn.

Presented within this section of the Joint Application for Permit is site-specific information with regard to these four proposed facilities. The information provided within the section addresses site-specific details for each proposed facility including, but not limited to, the following:

- General description of each proposed facility;
- Permits and approvals required;
- Alternatives analysis;
- Site plans, section views and detail drawings of each proposed action;
- Site photographs; and
- A copy of the New York City Local Department of City Planning Waterfront Revitalization Program Consistency Assessment form and supporting documentation for each proposed facility and a copy of the letter of Concurrence from the New York State Department of State.

The proposed facilities are presented within this section are as follows:

- North Shore Converted MTS;
- East 91st Street Converted MTS;
- Hamilton Avenue Converted MTS; and
- Southwest Brooklyn Converted MTS.
