<p>Under direct supervision, assists in the routine maintenance, operation and repair of public buildings and structures, and the equipment they contain; performs related work, such as driving to and from work sites. Replaces broken windows and door glass. Repairs windows and sash. Makes minor repairs to building electrical, plumbing and heating systems. Keep records. Assists in the relocating building equipment as directed. Makes minor repairs to masonry, woodwork, flooring and walls.</p>		
Qualification Requirements		
<p>1. Three years of full-time satisfactory experience as a mechanic, journey person or helper in the electrical trades, the mechanical trades, or the construction or maintenance of buildings; or 2. Not less than two years of such experience plus sufficient training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade or vocational high school to make up the equivalent of three years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of approved trade or vocational school; or 3. Education and/or experience which is equivalent to "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least two years of experience as specified in "1" above.</p>
