JOB DESCRIPTION:

The New York City Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD) provide youth and community services through contracts with Community-Based Organizations throughout New York City. DYCD's central task is administering available city, state, and federal funds to a wide range of innovative, practical and quality programs that positively impact youth and their communities.

The Senior Application Developer is responsible for analyzing user specifications and requirements that reflect business program needs, and subsequently delivering high-quality software solutions that meet business program needs. The incumbent must design, develop, test, maintain and modify software programs according to specifications, verifying logic, providing guidance to other developers, performing necessary debugging, and writing related documentation. By aligning skills with overall technology strategies, the incumbent is also called upon to develop interfaces and integrate systems. The candidate may be called upon to assist others on large and complex projects by analyzing and evaluating interrelationships of programs to determine how changes in one program will affect another. The selected person will work very closely with the DYCD IT project management group to assist in solving project related technical issues whether it pertains to custom development or evaluation of platforms and products. The candidate may also be called upon to perform a variety of duties to insure the proper operation of systems, to meet IT commitments to the business, and to leverage the strengths and skills of individuals within the overall team effectively.

- Responsible for the development and support of applications utilizing .NET technologies.
- Works at the highest level of all technical phases of programming; requires a high degree of creative thinking and the ability to use the accumulated knowledge and experience to guide others.
- Critically reviews all programs prior to implementation to verify consistency and conformance with established IT guidelines, policies and practices as well as industry standard guidelines; performs acceptance testing and program implementation for assigned systems and/or projects.
- Responsible for the underlying architecture for all software related projects assigned.
- Oversees the work being done by any other software engineers working on the project and coordinate with IT project management and Infrastructure teams.
- Mentors new or lower-level software developers or programmers, as well all the members on the development team
- Serve as an interface between the programmers and IT management.
- Has ownership of development plans and have supervisory responsibilities in delegating work and ensuring that software projects come in on time and under budget
- Serves as technical advisers to management and provide programming perspective on requirements

PREFERRED SKILLS:

- 3 + Years of experience in development of enterprise level software using .NET technologies, MVC 5, ASP.NET, VB.NET, ADO.NET, C#.NET, Web Forms, Windows Forms, Windows Services, LINQ, Asynchronous / Multithreaded Programming.
- Experience working on data integration and interface development related projects.
- Experience with security administration across multiple operating systems and especially Windows, Exchange, Cisco and SQL environments.
- Candidates must be highly analytical and effectively able to troubleshoot and prioritize needs, requirements and other issues.
- Aside from technical skills, prospective candidates should have excellent communications, teamwork, leadership and conflict management skills.
- Because of the constant developing nature of information systems and cyber-attacks, candidate must be committed to continuous learning and system development.
- Experience of working collaboratively with multidisciplinary cross-functional teams with a focus on delivery.
- Experience working with a shared services provider and operating environment.
- Experience in partnering with 3rd party application providers/vendors

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A master's degree in computer science from an accredited college and three years of progressively more responsible, full-time, satisfactory experience using information technology in computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, database administration, planning of data/information processing, user services, or area networks at least 18 months of this experience must have been in an administrative, managerial or executive capacity in the areas of computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, data base administration, or planning of data processing or in the supervision of staff performing these duties; or
2. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and four years of experience as described in "1" above; or
3. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent approved by a State's department of education or recognized accrediting organization and six years of experience as described in "1" above; or
4. A satisfactory combination of education and experience equivalent to "1", "2" or "3" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent approved by a State's department of education or recognized accrediting organization and must possess at least three years of experience as described in "1" above, including the 18 months of administrative, managerial, executive or supervisory experience as described in "1" above.

NOTE: The following types of experience are not acceptable: superficial use of preprogrammed software without complex programming, design, implementation or management of the product; use of word processing packages; use of a hand held calculator; primarily the entering or updating of data in a system; the operation of data processing hardware or consoles.
