**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The New York City Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD) supports youth and community services through contracts with a broad network of community-based organizations throughout New York City. Our central task is administering available city, state, and federal funds to a wide range of innovative, practical and quality programs that positively impact youth and communities.

Under supervision, with considerable latitude for independent judgment, DYCD is seeking a computer programmer on a team responsible for development and maintenance of agency core contract processing systems in a fast paced environment. This position encompasses many aspects of cross technology system development cycle, including coding, analysis, definition and documentation of business processes, business requirements and functional specifications, technical design and implementation as well as system test plans and system documentation. The work will focus on system modifications required or made necessary by the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA) and its attendant funding. The position will end coterminous with the ARRA funding.

  3. A master's degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience.
- However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience as described in "1" above.
