- If you deny the conditions exist as described in the Notice of Violation, please submit an explanation and documentation to support your claim.
- If you do not deny that these conditions exist on your property, please describe what efforts have been made to alleviate the problem.
- Have you hired a pest management professional or exterminator? If so please provide their name and proof that they are licensed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.
- If you hired a pest management professional or exterminator, please provide proof that includes the date that he/she was hired. Please include a detailed statement regarding the actions that he/she took to treat the cited conditions.
- Please state any other reason why you believe this ticket should be dismissed.
