
## Manhattan Waterfront Greenway Map



## **Grecian Temple**

Built in 1925 as a destination for pleasure drivers on the old Riverside Drive, the Grecian Temple stands on the eastern ridge of Fort Washington Park overlooking the Hudson River.



Little Red Lighthouse Built in 1880, the Little Red Lighthouse is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The lighthouse improved navigation on the Hudson until it was officially decommissioned in 1947.



**Cherry Walk** Stretching from 100th to 125th Street, this segment of the greenway extends more than a mile through Riverside Park. The path is graced by several dozen cherry trees that come to a dramatic blossom each

**Hudson River Park** This 550-acre park stretches from The Battery to 59th Street and will include 13 public piers, a marine estuary, upland parks, a waterfront esplanade and a bikeway.
