**2.9 OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES AT EMERGENCIES**

Emergency Procedures, Steam, dated October 20, 2011; titled *Steam System Emergencies*, is **amended** as follows: **Delete:** Section 2.2 **Insert:** New Section 2.2, to read:

Steam pressures in generating plants can be as high as 2,000 psi with temperatures reaching 900°F. Steam pressures in the buried supply piping and in supplied buildings can be as high as 170 psi and temperatures as high as 350°F.
