## 2.2 USE OF BULLETIN BOARDS IN QUARTERS

All members must comply with the regulations Section 19.2 titled "*Use of Quarters*". Particular focus must be placed on strictly complying with Section 19.2.2, 5<sup>th</sup> Paragraph, which states, "Bulletin boards in facilities shall be used only for official Department business or important information relating to approved Departmental organizations." In addition to applicable EEO restrictions, material presenting opinions or viewpoints is not permitted anywhere in quarters. It does not matter whether such opinions or views concern Department matters or non-Department matters. NO articles/material may be posted from any publications, internet or other sources. As stated in Section 19.2.2, 8<sup>th</sup> Paragraph, "Chief and company officers will be held strictly responsible for ensuring full compliance with this section."

***This section shall be read at all roll calls for four calendar days following the date of receipt of this order.*** The names of members who have been informed of this policy shall be recorded in the company journal.

## 2.3 CFR CERTIFICATION AND ELIGIBILITY

Department members who have taken the NYS CFR exam on November 17, 2011, and have received a passing grade, are eligible to perform CFR duties effective 0900 hours, December 29, 2011.

They shall immediately provide a copy of their certificate and/or test results to their Company Commander. Company Commanders upon receiving a copy of the member's NYS CFR certificate shall record particulars in the Office Record Journal as per CFR Manual, Chapter 1, Section 5.1. A copy of the certificate shall be placed in the member's personnel folder. The CFR Training unit (718) 281-8469 shall be immediately notified any time a member fails the NYS CFR exam. The CFR Training unit will provide information regarding retaking the NYS exam.
