#### 2.3 POSTING OF MATERIAL IN QUARTERS

**The following information supersedes section 2.2 of Department Order No. 89 dated December 29, 2011.**

All members must comply with the regulations Section 19.2 titled "*Use of Quarters*". Particular focus must be placed on strictly complying with Section 19.2.2, 5<sup>th</sup> Paragraph, which states, "Bulletin boards in facilities shall be used only for official Department business or important information relating to approved Departmental organizations." This restriction applies to the posting of material anywhere in quarters, not just on bulletin boards. Similarly, EEO restrictions apply anywhere in quarters. As stated in Section 19.2.2, 8<sup>th</sup> Paragraph, "Chief and company officers will be held strictly responsible for ensuring full compliance with this section."
