2.1.1 NYPD LETTER OF GRATITUDE

The following is a reprint of a letter of gratitude to the New York City Fire Department issued by the NYPD Chief of Department:

From flying the police department flag on fire engines and ladder trucks, to hand-delivering trays of food to Brian's precinct in Queens, to distributing bottles of water at his funeral on Long Island, no act was insignificant, and none went unnoticed by the members of my department.
