2.3 SEEKING FDNY PERSONNEL WHO SERVED DURING THE VIETNAM WAR

The Fire Department has partnered with the U.S. Vietnam War Commemoration project to honor members who served active military duty from November 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975. The FDNY will be hosting a special event in late Spring 2016 to pay tribute to all agency employees - active, retired, uniformed and civilian - who served in the various branches of the U.S. military during those years. We are working with various veterans and fraternal groups in the Department in compiling a list of eligible honorees, who will be presented with the official Vietnam Veteran Lapel Pin created by Congress to honor Vietnam Veterans, as well as formal recognition of their service from the Fire Commissioner and Chief of Department. 2.7 PAYROLL AND CHECKS
