OPERATION BIO-POD 2020

- 1 Our yearly commitment to conducting our Bio-POD drill is two-fold:
 - To ensure the safety of the members in the performance of their duties in response to a Biological or Radiological incident.
 - Bio-POD is part of the FDNY Continuation of Operational Procedures (COOP) Plan.
- This year's drill will be held on the following five (5) days from **0800-2300 hours**:
 - Sunday, October 18
 - Saturday, October 24
 - Sunday, November 1
 - Saturday, November 7
 - Sunday, November 15
- There will be one (1) Stationary POD site for each borough which will be utilized for all 5 days of the Bio-POD Drill:

Stationary PODs:

- **Brooklyn** EMS Station 38 554 Winthrop Street, Brooklyn, NY 11203

- Staten Island EMS Station 22, Seaview Hospital, 460 Brielle Avenue, SI, NY 10314
- 4 **Instructions:** At the start of the tour, Station Officers are directed to go to the DiamondPlate Kiosk.
 - From the homepage, click BIOPOD Consent
 - Print and distribute to every on-duty member.
 - Each member must complete the form and keep it with them during the tour.
 - > Each unit must report to the BIOPOD location when dispatched.
 - Each member must report to the location even if they worked and reported on an earlier tour unless both members have already reported to a BioPod location. At that point notify the dispatcher to be placed back in service.

Note: The Kiosks at Firehouses and EMS Stations functioning as POD Locations may be utilized by BHS Administrative staff during the Bio-POD operational period.

- Members are to observe social distancing rules with a mask mandate in effect for anyone entering a government building, which includes FDNY firehouses and EMS stations, even if they are more than 6 feet apart.
- Off-duty members and civilian employees are welcome to attend on their own time to receive the Flu vaccine. They must present their Department ID.
