2.1.1 BOROUGHWIDE PLAQUE DEDICATIONS - BRONX

One of our most important traditions is our plaque dedication ceremonies. Our extended FDNY family gathers on these days to remember those we have lost, honor their sacrifice, and celebrate their lives. Unfortunately, these events were not possible in the last year due to the health and safety guidelines in place for gatherings. As a result, we now find ourselves with more than 50 plaque dedications that have not yet been held.

This summer, we will hold FDNY Boroughwide Memorial Plaque Ceremonies at our Fire Academy on Randall's Island, our EMS Academy at Fort Totten in Queens, and at FDNY Headquarters in Brooklyn. These ceremonies will honor active FDNY members who have died and members who have died due to World Trade Center illnesses. The first of these Boroughwide Plaque Dedications will be held at the FDNY Fire Training Academy on Randall's Island, NY, on Wednesday, July 14, 2021 at 1000 hours.
