2.4 FDNY OFFICERS MANAGEMENT INSTITUTE (FOMI)

The Department is currently accepting applications for the 2022 FDNY Officers Management Institute (FOMI). Eligible applicants for this advanced management training program include Fire Deputy and Battalion Chiefs, Fire Captains on the Battalion Chief promotional list, EMS Chiefs, Supervising Fire Marshals, Assistant Commissioners and above. Through continued support from the FDNY Foundation, the Department partners with Columbia University to offer a curriculum that provides a solid foundation in proven management and leadership principles.

FOMI is a six-month program (January – June) held at General Electric's Global Leadership Development Institute in Ossining, New York. Sessions will be held in person during the following dates:

Week 1: January 23 - 27
Week 2: February 20 - 24
Week 3: March 20 - 24
Week 4: April 24 - 28
Week 5: May 15 - 19
Week 6: June 5 - 9

To ensure the safety of all faculty, staff and participants, GE has implemented a mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination policy at their facility.
