

Dear Member:

Recently, New York City employees were emailed an important message from **Mayor Michael Bloomberg** concerning World Trade Center (WTC) related federal programs created as a result of the [James Zadroga 9/11 Health and Compensation Act](#), which New York City strongly supported.

With the 12th anniversary of the September 11th terrorist attacks fast approaching, we thought it important to highlight those aspects of the Mayor's message that may be of particular relevance to our members.

Your receipt of this letter indicates that YOU are ALREADY enrolled in the WTC Health Program at FDNY for monitoring and treatment. Re-enrollment is not necessary.

You are NOT automatically registered in the September 11<sup>th</sup> Victim Compensation Fund. You may be eligible for financial compensation if you were *physically* injured, including WTC-related illnesses such as asthma, emphysema or certain cancers.

Registration is a personal decision, but if you choose to do so, the deadline is **Thursday, October 3rd, 2013**. Medical documents are not required by the deadline but will be requested after registration.
