Alternative Issuance Procedure (AIP) Information for E-21

This document provides the procedures to follow in order to obtain a **Certificate of Fitness for Powder Actuated Tools (E-21)** without a written exam administered by the New York City Fire Department.

Application for AIP must be submitted online. If the application meets all requirements, a Certificate of Fitness will be sent to the applicant's/company's mailing address within five business days.

Applicants must understand that the Fire Department reserves the right to randomly call up to test the applicants who are issued by AIP. Applicant who has failed the written exam will not be allowed to take advantage of this policy.

1. <u>How to Apply</u>:

- a. If you meet the requirements below you can submit an application(s) electronically online through NYC Business Express <u>https://www1.nyc.gov/nycbusiness/index#C</u>. Only a designated coordinator (DC) can submit application(s) on behalf of the company's employees. The company's authorized DC must be approved by FDNY. To request approval, email to <u>arayae@fdny.nyc.gov</u>
- 2. <u>Qualification Requirements:</u> (applicants must submit all supporting requirements electronically online)

2.1. Education, License and Experience Requirements

Applicants must have the following qualifications:

- A certificate or letter on an FDNY approved training company/institution's official letterhead stating that the applicant has participated in and completed the training program in the safe use of powder actuated tools AND a copy of the written letter issued by FDNY stating the training program has been reviewed and approved by FDNY AND one year of full-time, paid work experience using powder activated tools.

A recent photo (2x2 head shot) in JPG or JPEG format.

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2.4. Application Fee

The application fee for **E-21** is **\$ 25**. The following payment methods are acceptable:

- Credit Card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard, or Visa)
- Debit card (MasterCard or Visa)
- E-Check

For fee waivers please submit: (Only government employees who will use their C of F for their work-related responsibilities are eligible for fee waivers.)

- An agency letter with official letter head; AND
- Copy of identification card issued by the agency

A convenience fee of 2.49% will be applied to all credit card payments.

3. <u>Renewal Information</u>

FDNY also reserves the right to require the applicants to take a re-examination upon submission of the renewal application. This Certificate of Fitness must be renewed every *THREE YEARS*.
