A place where FDNY employees and retirees can receive assistance with the following:

- Filing insurance claims for property damaged or lost in Hurricane Sandy
- Applying for disaster assistance with US Dept. of Homeland Security (FEMA)
- Making an appointment to talk to FEMA representative (**appointment required**)
- Applying with UFA and UFOA for one-time financial assistance in the amount of \$500 (Only for active Firefighters and Officers whose homes are uninhabitable)
- Peer Program representatives offering help in overcoming difficulties created by Hurricane Sandy
- Emergency mental health counseling

FDNY Employee Support Services

The FDNY responds to any crisis that arises in order to meet needs of our members and their families. In the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy we have created FDNY Employee Support Services to offer FDNY employees and retirees one place that they can come to receive information and help needed.

In our two office locations employees can file insurance claims, apply for disaster assistance with US Department of Homeland Security (FEMA); and receive information regarding immediate help offered by Red Cross (shelter information, hot meal availability, essential relief supplies and basic health services). Employees will be able to speak with FEMA representatives **by appointment only**. Please call 718-922-2981 (Brooklyn office) or 718-448-2391 (SI office) to schedule an appointment.

FDNY/CSU's Peer Outreach Program has been in place for many years. Representatives of this program will be present at both locations offering education and a sympathetic ear. These are people who have been where you are and can relate to what you are going through.

We will offer emergency mental health counseling on site. For information regarding further counseling please call FDNY CSU at 212-570-1693. Informational materials regarding obtaining mental help for adults and children are available at office sites.

All active Firefighters and Officers, whose homes are uninhabitable, will be able to apply for one-time financial assistance in the amount of \$500. This assistance is provided by the UFA and UFOA. Please have your IAFF number readily available.


