**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The Health Surveillance Statistician will assist with statistical inquiries, analyses, and evaluations of a large health information data set. Databases queried will include disease surveillance reports and aggregated outcomes data derived from the FDNY World Trade Center Medical Monitoring and Treatment Programs. These programs involve the long-term tracking of hundreds of health metrics in a 15,500 member cohort, and tables consistently need to be joined in order for meaningful data to be accessed. In addition, responsible for managing significant amounts of WTC Program financial data and performing frequent budget analyses.

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college including or supplemented by 24 credits in mathematics, computer science, operations research, and/or statistics, of which 6 credits must be in statistics; or
  2. An associate degree or 60 credits from an accredited college including or supplemented by 24 credits in mathematics, computer science, operations research, and/or statistics, of which 6 credits must be in statistics and two years of full-time professional statistical work experience; or
  3. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" or "2" above.
