JOB DESCRIPTION:

Under supervision, the Machinist does bench, general shop and outside machinist work, including the following: Sets up and operates machine shop equipment and tools, such as engine lathes, shapers, milling machines, drill presses, planers and grinders. Inspects, overhauls and repairs all types of equipment. Uses machinist tools and instruments. Prepares reports and requisitions; maintains records and inventories of supplies and materials. May operate a motor vehicle or other motorized equipment in the performance of assigned duties.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last 15 years as a machinist; or
2. At least two and one-half years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last ten years as a machinist plus sufficient full-time experience as a machinist helper or an apprentice machinist, or training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade, technical or vocational high school, to make up the equivalent of the remaining required experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of helper or apprentice experience or approved trade or vocational high school, up to a maximum of two and one-half years.

License Requirement

For appointment to positions in certain agencies, a Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York is required. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

NOTE: New York City residency is required within 90 days of appointment. However, City employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County. To determine if the residency requirement applies to you, please discuss with the agency Human Resources Representative at time of interview.
