**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

Reporting directly to the OSHA Director, City Research Scientist will conduct environmental, health and safety audits of facilities and/or operations to ensure compliance with federal, state or local regulations and policies. Prepare technical reports that identify deficiencies and provide recommended corrective actions. Research local, state and federal laws and regulations to determine applicability to facilities and/or operations. Ensure compliance with OSHA and NYS Department of Labor (PESH) regulations. Make and record observations on the progress of research investigations and evaluate data. Assist in the agency’s research efforts and environmental, health and safety issues, and other research projects. Conduct workplace assessments/audits/investigations and understand industrial processes. Collect and analyze occupational illness and injury data. Perform air monitoring and/or other industrial hygiene measurements utilizing a variety of technical equipment. Assist OSHA Director with research and presentations. Responsible for data gathering and various technical and administrative tasks.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

**For Assignment Level I** (only physical, biological and environmental sciences and public health)

A master's degree from an accredited college or university with a specialization in an appropriate field of physical, biological or environmental science or in public health.

**PREFERRED SKILLS:**

A valid motor vehicle driver’s license in the State of New York. This must be maintained for the duration of employment.

**NOTE:** New York City residency is required within 90 days of appointment. However, City employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County.
