**JOB DESCRIPTION**

The New York City Fire Department is hiring for a Plumber position in the Bureau of Facilities Management. Under supervision, plumber performs work relating to the installation, alteration, maintenance and repair of piping of gas, water heaters and other gas systems. Installs and repairs portable water lines, fixtures including faucets, basins, water closets, urinals, CFRD sinks. Ensure that all systems coincide with rules, codes and regulations. Other tasks include repair of sanitary and storm waste piping and installation.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience as a plumber acquired within the past ten years; or
2. Not less than three years of full-time satisfactory experience described in "1" above plus sufficient full-time experience as a plumber's helper or apprentice, or training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade school, technical school or vocational high school, to make up the equivalent of five years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of helper or apprentice experience or approved schooling, up to a maximum of two years of satisfactory experience.

The apprenticeship must be recognized by the New York State Department of Labor, the U.S. Department of Labor or any apprenticeship council which is recognized by the U.S. Department of Labor. The schooling must be approved by a state's Department of Education or comparable agency.

**License Requirements**

A Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

For assignment as a licensed plumber, must possess and maintain the license(s) required to perform those duties.

**NOTE:** New York City residency is required within 90 days of appointment. However, City employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County.
