JOB DESCRIPTION

The candidate will serve as an Oracle Database Administrator for the Business Application Systems and Support Group. The responsibilities are:

Design and implement Oracle database applications responsible for database design including creating the application schema, building object and relational tables, populating the database, and controlling database security; analyze user requirements, current operational procedures, and identify problems to improve existing computer system; create and maintain table spaces, data files, indices, partitions and other storage considerations; maintain data integrity and consistency involving the Oracle 11g database or higher; coordinate development, testing, installation, and modification of Oracle Database Applications programs; install and configure Oracle software on Linux, Solaris and Windows NT platforms; administer Production, Test, Development and DR database environments.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Professional/vendor certification(s) in wide area network administration that is required for the position to be filled. In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in wide area network planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; or
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in "1" above; or
3. A master's degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory (not classroom based) full-time information technology experience as described in "1" above.

Please Note: In addition to meeting the minimum Qualification Requirements:

Incumbents may be required to update existing and/or obtain additional professional industry-standard certification(s) for current and future technical environment(s) in which they may be assigned to work, as determined by the employing agency.

PREFERRED SKILLS:

Professional/vendor certification(s) in database administration that is required for the position to be filled. NYC Acceptable Professional/Vendor Certificates are: Oracle 11g DBA Oracle Certified Professional, Oracle (OCP). Working knowledge of Oracle Exadata will be a plus. Good written and Verbal communication skills.

NOTE: New York City residency is required within 90 days of appointment.
