**JOB DESCRIPTION**

The Computer Systems Manager, M-I will serve as a manager in charge of a team of DBAs and Applications Administrators for the Bureau of Technology Development and Systems. The Data Systems Manager will be responsible for the architecture design, implementation and administration of complex systems that include database servers, application servers and management servers; manage a team of administrators to ensure production, training, testing, development, and disaster recovery environments are operational and well maintained; operate as the chief architect for the FDNY Database Enterprise Model and all Middleware Applications and will manage the day to day interactions with the Application Development Unit and the Application Support and Service Unit. The job will require 24/7 on call status and will coordinate with various managers in Networking, WAN and LAN. The successful candidate will be reporting to the Director of Business Applications Systems & Support.

A master's degree in computer science from an accredited college and three years of progressively more responsible, full-time, satisfactory experience using information technology in computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, database administration, planning of data/information processing, user services, or area networks at least 18 months of this experience must have been in an administrative, managerial or executive capacity in the areas of computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, data base administration, or planning of data processing or in the supervision of staff performing these duties; or
