The New York City Human Rights Law prohibits source of income discrimination, which protects tenants who pay their rent with public assistance through programs such as Section 8, the Living in Communities Rental Assistance Program (LINC), Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and others. Tenant harassment is also illegal under several statutes, including the New York City Human Rights Law.
