

In an average year, New Yorkers will report over 200,000 incidents of domestic abuse to the police. In 2005 Mayor Michael R. Bloomberg established the NYC Family Justice Center Initiative to reduce the many barriers faced by victims of domestic violence who are seeking help. With three centers now open in the Bronx, Queens and Brooklyn, this initiative enables domestic violence victims to access legal, housing and counseling services in their language in one central location while their children play safely in a specially designated children's room.
