 Report Template Activation, (revised March 28) link to the City no later than
 11:59pm on May 1 to avoid being issued a non-compliance violation.
- The City advises all users to run the <u>Data Quality Checker in Portfolio Manager</u> to identify errors in the benchmarking data entries before submitting the LL84 report.
- BBLs and BINs should only be inputted into the new customized Standard ID fields, "NYC Borough, Block and Lot (BBL)," and "NYC Building Identification Number (BIN)," respectively.
