

# Notice of violation

- A notice of violation is mailed to the **building owner** listed in Department of Finance's records. (Make sure the building's and building owner's information is up-to-date in DOF records.)
- Violations incur a penalty amount of \$500 per violation and may be issued up to four times per year for a total of \$2,000 annually. Violations may be issued for each of the compliance deadlines: May 1, August 1, November 1 and February 1.

# Resolving A Benchmarking Violation

To resolve a LL84/09 Benchmarking violation the building owner must:

- Pay the \$500 penalty for failure to file the benchmarking report.
- Submit the energy benchmarking compliance report by the next quarterly deadline to avoid another notice.
  
- To Pay the outstanding penalty:
  - Make certified/bank check or money order payable to the NYC Department of Buildings, as per Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York § 103-06(I).
    - Include the violation number and BBL on check or money order.
  
  - Mail payment to NYC Department of Buildings, Sustainability Enforcement Unit, 280 Broadway, 7th floor, New York, NY 10007.
    - Include a copy of the notice of violation.

# Challenging a Benchmarking Violation

To challenge a LL84/09 Benchmarking notice of violation, please:

- Complete the Local Law 84/2009 Benchmarking Violation Challenge Form, available on DOB's website:
