

Her entire professional career has been focused on the education and treatment of patients with asthma and allergies. In the recent past, she has worked as National Program Director of the Asthma Care Network, a program that delivered asthma education to health care professionals at the point of care in primary care physician offices. In 2008, she graduated from the University of Tennessee Health Science Center with a Doctorate in Nursing Practice.
