MODEL CELL COMES TO THE NETWORK

HHC has embarked on a new initiative to standardize Med/Surg supply rooms throughout the Corporation. This is not only to improve the workflow in the Central Stores Warehouses, but also on the Nursing Units. A team from Central Office will be visiting each site to work with Materials Management and Nursing to redo 2 or 3 storage rooms at each site. They will train staff to complete the conversion of the other nursing supply rooms and to monitor and maintain progress. The rooms are labeled; pictures of the items are on the front of the drawers; there is a directory in each room; and items are categorized and color coded. This helps staff locate

items quickly from floor to floor and room to room.

So far, Harlem Hospital has converted 3 Nursing supply rooms: the Emergency Department (Peds and Adult), CCU, and Adult ICU. Lincoln Hospital has completed SICU and is starting on the Emergency Department. The Diagnostic and Treatment Centers will be next. Sequndo Belvis is first, starting in October, followed by Morrisania and Renaissance.
